Three problems, three treatments ...
Angela Donaldson talks to women who
sought alternatives and got results

3 gentle therapies

Alternative therapies have a wide range of applications for many health problems. If you've toyed with the idea of trying a complementary therapy but haven't ventured down that path, read how three different treatments helped three women who had almost given up hope.

ACUENERGETICS

PATIENT: Kirsty Cassidy, 40, of Redfern, NSW, freelance stylist and mother to Bibi, now aged two.

PROBLEM: Unable to fall pregnant.



KIRSTY'S STORY

"My husband, Tim, and I been trying to fall pregnant for about four years. During that time, we tried acupuncture, visualisation therapy, meditation, shiatsu and kinesiology.

Acupuncture was great because it got me to look at all aspects of my life and it made me slow down. Meditation helped by creating stillness and calm in my busy mind and the



world around me. I was also seeing a naturopath to get my diet in order. I had two operations for endometriosis and we tried two rounds of intrauterine insemination (IUI).
